



C TOURNAMENT SYSTEMS

C/7 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP INDIVIDUAL ARTISTIC

Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS

16 inscribed sportsmen. + 8 placed sportsmen

Art. 2. INSCRIPTION and PARTICIPATION of the SPORTSMEN

Consideration of registration as following:

1. Title holder
2. Representant of the organizer
3. Consideration of the federations according to the list of inscriptions.
First, the first of each registered federation that is not already considered by the placed sportsmen. Then the sportsmen inscribed in second place and so on.
4. The sportsmen entered freely by the date of registration to a total of 24.

Art. 3. SYSTEM – BEGINNING of the SET

The system of sets is applied (best of 5).

The games begin by cushion drawing. The sportsman who begins the first set, will also begin the third and possibly the fifth set. The opponent will begin the second and possibly the fourth set. The sportsman who wins the cushion drawing, has the option to start himself or let the opponent start. The starting sportsman always starts each figure of the sets 1, 3 and maybe 5.

Art. 4. TIE-BREAK

If a set does not have winner, a tie-break will follow playing the first figure of the next set. If sportsmen fail this figure one will play the next figure until decision: when a sportsman has failed a figure and the opponent was successful, the set is finished. The tie-break will be started by the athlete who has started the set.

Art. 5. END of SET

If an athlete cannot be joined by his opponent in one set, the set is complete.

Art. 6. GROUP GAMES

The 16 inscribed sportsmen are divided into four groups with four sportsmen in the Z system according the updated CEB ranking. Starting with the sportsmen enrolled in the first places, then those in second places and so on and so on, and finally those entered freely according to their date of registration, while placing sportsmen of the same nationality in different groups. In the case where several sportsmen of the same nationality are in the same group they will meet first.

The top two from each group qualify for the final round.

Art. 7. RANKING CRITERIA

The classification of groups will be conducted using the following criteria:

- a) Match points (W = 2 Pts / L = 0 Pt)
- b) Percentage = $\frac{\text{Total succeed points}}{\text{Total possible points}} \times 100 =$ % (three decimal places rounded down)
- c) Direct encounter (Result of the game sportsmen between them)

Art. 8. FINAL ROUND

The final round will be played in KO system.

The encounters / parties are as follows:

Place 1	Title holder
Places 2 to 7	6 first ranking of CEB
Place 8	representative of the organizer
Places 9 to 12	4 first of the groups (ranking after the groups)
Places 13 to 16	4 second of the groups (ranking after the groups)

Art. 9. FINAL RANKING

The ranking will be done according to the following criteria:

1. Placement according to the winner or loser for the places 1 to 3 / 4
2. Reached rounds
3. Percentage = $\frac{\text{Total succeed points}}{\text{Total possible points}} \times 100 =$ % (three decimal places rounded down)

Art. 10. PROGRAM of the FIGURES

The "artistic" program of 98 figures is divided into 14 sets with 7 figures.

Art. 11. DRAWING of the FIGURES

At the beginning of the tournament a draw will decide, with what a set one begins on billiard 1; on billiard 2 one begins with the set of the 3rd next letter and so on. Before the start of 1/4, 1/2 and final a new draw of the beginning set will take place.

Art. 12. HELP

It is allowed sportsmen to use an elevation with a maximum height of 5 cm (overall).

Art. 13. ATTEMPTS

The usual 3 attempts are given to all sportsmen, but they are irrelevant to the final classification.

Art. 14. DRESS CODE

Regulations regarding the dress code of the CEB will apply.

It is not allowed to play shirt sleeves rolled up, except the figure request (ex. Figure 44). Permission is granted to sportsmen, for "piques" and "masses", to wear a sweater.

The referee shall enforce the measures set out above.

Art. 15. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM / ENCOUNTERS

It will be played following the joined KO scheme.
