C/24 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS Small Tables U19

Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS

8 inscribed teams.

Each federation affiliated to the CEB has the right to inscribe two youth club team where the first team will first be considered.

- 1 The sportsmen should not be 20 years old on September 1st of this CEB sports season (Having played the national championships in youth conditions, under 19 on the 1st September of the sports year before).
- 2 A federation not able to appoint a club team, can inscribe a combination of two clubs. In this case the teams have to play national qualifications. These results are to be submitted to the youth director of the CEB during registration.

Art. 2. INSCRIPTION and PARTICIPATION of the TEAMS

The inclusion of entries is as follows:

1. Title holder
2. Representative of the organizer
3. First team listed in the first place of the other federations ranked by the latest CE. If there are not enough inscriptions, we will complete as following:
B-Team of the Federation of the title
B-Team of the federation of the organizer
B-Team federations ranked by the latest CE

Art. 3. GENERAL RULES

Each team consists of three sportsmen.

The sportsmen meet according to their ranking.

A Team / Sportsman 1 (Rank 1) against B Team / Sportsman 1 (Rank 1) etc. ..

Points to play for each sportsman will be calculated according to Articles 7 by the CEB youth director before the start of the competition.

Art. 4. GROUP GAMES

The eight registered teams will be placed in two groups of four teams according the system Z. Starting with the teams entered in the first place, then those listed in second places etc. .. The teams with the same nationality will be placed, regardless of their classification in different groups. The second team of the same federation advances one group. The origin team will take the place of the team that has been moved.

If a team withdraws after the composition of the groups, the replacement team will take the place of the missing team.

The sportsman who has achieved first the distance to play, has won the game.

The classification of groups is the following criteria:

- 1 match points
- 2 party points
- 3 Overall average

Art. 5. FINAL RANKING

The final ranking will be determined by direct encounters.

A1 - B1 for places 1 + 2

A2 - B2 places for 3 + 4

A3 - B3 for places 5 + 6

A4 - B4 for places 7 + 8

The sportsman who has achieved first the distance to play, has won the game.

Art. 6. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM / DISTANCES

One will play the free game (with large corners) according the "handicap formula". The director of youth

CEB will set the number of points to play for each sportsman based on Article 7. The overall averages that have been performed on the small table (2.10 x 1.05), will be considered.

If the cue-ball is in contact with another ball, all balls will be placed on the points of departure.
