## Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS

24 registered sportsmen.

## Art. 2. INSCRIPTION and PARTICIPATION of the SPORTSMEN

Each affiliated federation has the right to register sportsmen.

1. Place 1 Title holder.
2. Then 1 representative of each registered federation.
3. 1 place for the organizer (not applied if the organizer is directly CEB)
4. The list will be completed to 24 by registered players, according to their place in the CEB ranking

The entry ranking will be:

1. According the CEB ranking
2. By drawing if they are not under point 1 .

## Art. 3. DISCIPLINES and GAME DISTANCES

The disciplines are :Cadre 47/2 - Cadre 71/2 - and Cushion One will play on following distances:

## Art. 4. GROUP GAMES

The classification of the 24 sportsmen will be made as described in Art. 2.
Then 8 groups of 3 sportsmen will be formed according to the system Z, while placing sportsmen of the same nationality in different groups. In the case where several sportsmen of the same nationality are in the group they will meet first.
One will play with equality of innings. A draw is possible.
The first of each group will qualify for the final round.
The classification of the eliminated sportsmen will be done according to the criteria listed in the "Basic
Concepts of the Sport."

## Art. 5. FINAL ROUND

The final round will be played in KO system. The eight qualified sportsmen will meet as determined in the following article. One will play with equality of innings.
In case of draws extra times will be played as described in the Basic Concepts of the Sporting Program.
The encounters / parties result from the classification of the qualification.
Art. 6. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM / ENCOUNTERS
It will be played following the joined scheme.
