## C/1 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP LADIES FREE GAME SMALL TABLES

## Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS

## 8 athletes.

If requested by an organizer, this competition can be played with 12 players.

## Art. 2. INSCRIPTION AND PARTICIPATION

CEB affiliated federations have the right to register athletes according to the following priorities: 1- The Title Holder if registered (PLACED).
2-1 Wild card for the organizer or 2 if 12 players. (PLACED)
3- Athletes registered as first (NORMAL 1) by all federations. If the number of 8 is not reached the athletes registered as seconds will be accepted (NORMAL 2). The federations priority order for the second athlete and further is determined by the nations standings of last European Championship, each nation is considered only once for the best standing. Federations not represented in the last European Championship will be considered as last.
If the number of 8 (or 12) is not reached athletes registered as third, then fourth etc, will be accepted according the same criteria..

## Art. 3. GROUP GAMES - GAME DISTANCE 120 POINTS - 15 INNINGS - BIG CORNER -STARTING POINT IF CONTACT

An entry ranking is made of the registered athletes, listed as their overall averages. Then groups of four athletes are set up according to the system $Z$. The game will be played with equal innings. If the athlete does not reach the distance of 120 points after the 15th inning, the opponent will also have this inning. For this the balls are placed on the starting position. A draw is possible.

Determination of ranking in the groups:

1. Game points
2. General average
3. Best game average
4. Highest run, second highest run.
5. The direct comparison of the athletes who are then still equal
6. Decision by drawing lots

With 8 participants the two first of each group will be qualified for the semi-finals.
With 12 participants the two first of each group and 2 best third are qualified to the quarter finals:

## Art. 4. FINAL ROUND - GAME DISTANCE 150 POINTS - BIG CORNER - STARTING POINT IF CONTACT

The final round will be played in KO-System. The game will be played with equal innings.
The ranking for the KO round with 12 players is determined as follows:

1. Placing in the group
2. Game points
3. General average
4. Best game average
5. Highest run, second highest run.
6. Decision by drawing lots

Art. 5. MATCHES OF THE FINAL ROUND.
It will be played according the joined scheme.
