



C/3/4/5 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP INDIVIDUAL CLASSIC

Art. 1. PARTICIPANTS

16 athletes.

Art. 2. INSCRIPTION AND PARTICIPATION OF THE ATHLETES

Each affiliated federation has the right to register athletes according the following list:

1. The Title Holder (PLACED)
2. 1 Wild card for the organizer federation, if the organizer is not CEB. (PLACED).
3. First two athletes in the concerned CEB Ranking in force at the opening of registrations (PLACED). If the Title Holder is in the first two position of the ranking or one or more of these athletes are not registered the following athlete(s) in the ranking will be placed.
4. Athletes registered as first (NORMAL 1) by all federations. If the number of 16 is not reached the athletes registered as seconds will be accepted (NORMAL 2). The federations priority order is determined by the concerned CEB ranking taking in consideration only the nationality of the athletes, each nation is considered only once for the best standing. If the total number of participant is not reached same criteria will be applied for third, fourth etc..(NORMAL 3,4 etc..). Federations not represented in the ranking will be considered as last.

Art. 3. DISCIPLINES AND GAME DISTANCES

The disciplines are :Cadre 47/2, Cadre 71/2 and 1-Cushion.

Games will be played on following distances:

	47/2	71/2	1-Cushion
Group games	200 points	150 points	100 points
Final round	250 points	200 points	120 points

Art. 4. GROUP GAMES

The entry ranking will be created as follows:

1. According to the position of the athletes in the CEB ranking.
2. Athletes not present in the ranking will be put at the end of the entry ranking by draw.

Four groups of 4 athletes will be formed according to the system Z taking in consideration that athletes of the same nation shall not be allocated to the same group. If this occurs a deviation will be applied according to art.11 of the "Basic Concepts of the Sporting Program".

Matches will be played with equality of innings. A draw is possible.

The first two of each group will qualify for the quarter finals.

The classification of the qualified and the eliminated sportsmen will be done according to the criteria listed in the "Basic Concepts of the Sporting Program".

Art. 5. FINAL ROUND

The final round will be played in KO system. The eight qualified athlete will meet as determined in the following article. Matches will be played with equality of innings.

In case of draws extensions will be played as described in the Basic Concepts of the Sporting Program.

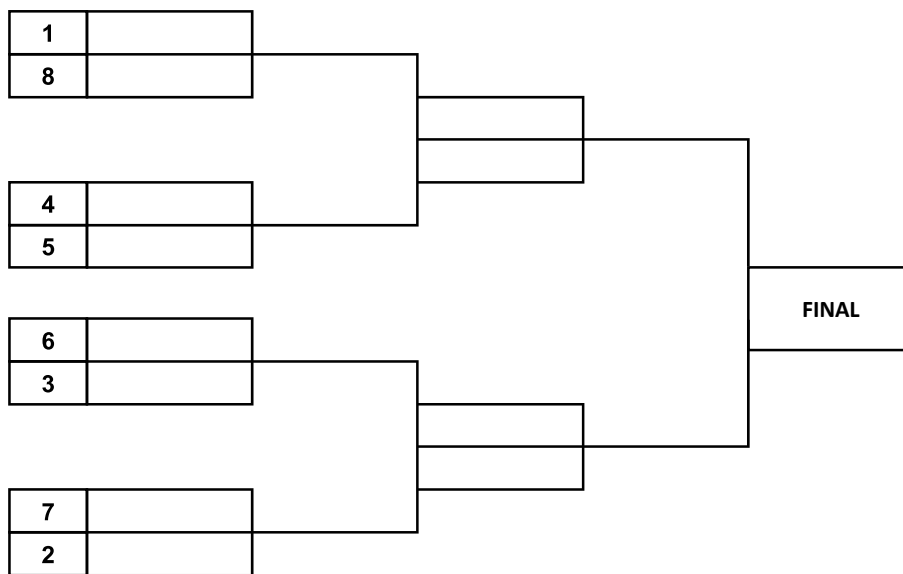
